授業目的							

This course focuses on improving your oral communication in English as a Lingua Franca (ELF) and increasing your cross-cultural understanding. This will enable you to expand your horizons and interact more effectively with people from around the world. Fun and interactive lessons will develop your language proficiency while helping you gain confidence and fluency in English. Successful completion of this class is a prerequisite for CEP 2.

各回毎の授業内容

CEP 1 is a Monday through Friday, one-semester course that contains lessons about a variety of everyday situations and topics, such as describing your interests, making requests, and discussing health. Each unit includes:

- an introduction to the topic
- · a vocabulary and grammar section focusing on practical use
- pronunciation practice
- listening comprehension of short conversations
- · short, practical reading and writing activities
- · discussions and role-plays with classmates

Self-study:

Before each class, students should spend 15 minutes preparing presentation materials and doing extensive reading. After each lesson, students should spend 15 minutes reviewing the lesson's contents and doing any assigned homework.

成績評価方法

CEP classes observe a 60-40 rule: 60% of your final grade will come from class standing, and 40% will come from assessments. The exact breakdown for CEP 1 will be announced in the first class.

Feedback: Before, during, and after the semester, you will receive feedback about your performance in class through face-to-face and written methods.

Green, Orange, and Purple classes will use Four Corners 2 (2012) by Jack C. Richards and David Bohlke. New York, NY: Cambridge University Press.

Yellow, Blue, and Red classes will use Four Corners 3. (2012) by Jack C. Richards and David Bohlke. New York, NY: Cambridge University Press

In addition to the textbook, your teacher may use worksheets, handouts, video, and other materials.

Reading materials for the Extensive Reading (ER) portion of the course include Cambridge Readers and other materials of your choice, and are available in the campus library.
