CEP5 and CEP6 will help you to develop critical thinking skills in order to deepen your understanding on global issues. It will also enable you to engage in cross-cultural understanding through a high level of proficiency in English.

### 各回毎の授業内容

#### 1. Overview

In each unit of the course, you will first watch a video clip. Then you will go through two listening practices, each giving an opportunity for language development and critical thinking. All these culminates in a speaking task for which all data gathering and preparation are done independently by the learner.

#### 2 Units

The units to be covered will depend on which CEP5/6 class you are in. Your teacher will make an announcement in the first class.

#### 3. Self-study

This course requires 30 minutes of preparation and 30 minutes of revision per lesson. These should include self-study of the vocabulary, grammar and common oral expressions in each unit.
