授業目的

OVERVIEW & OBJECTIVES

The aim of this course is to develop students' interest and understanding of travel and tourism English. Students will learn about basic knowledge of tourism industries such as tourist companies, hotels, airlines, and any related field as well as travel English.

This course will be composed of lectures and practices to develop students' understanding of traveling overseas and English related to travel business including airlines, travel agency, hotel accommodations. In each class, a topic will be given to students who are guided into opinions in English. They will boost their confidence in speaking and listening with rich practice using typical travel situations.

This course also includes "Self-directed Learning" as a supplement to classroom learning. Through the course carried out as part of this class, students also acquire the ability to take responsibility for their own studies. This experience in the course helps them become proactive and autonomous language learners who are capable of effectively learning the foreign languages they choose as part of basic education, or the language they will be using while studying abroad the second semester of this year.

- As the additional criterion (10%), students who passed/ got the following certificates: 2nd grade of EIKEN, or higher/600 points TOEIC, or higher/2nd or 3rd grade of TOURISM ENGLISH PROFICIENCY TEST are added to the comprehensive evaluation, and students who extensively read a maximum number of 125,000 words about any materials written in English are also added to the final test.

受講に当たっての留意事項

EXPECTATIONS:

Attendance is very important. Students must attend 90% of all classes. Only personal or family emergencies and medical care are recognized as legitimate absences; otherwise, students are expected to attend classes. All the language courses at NUIS require students' participation in every class. Therefore, late arrivals are not tolerated. "2" late arrivals are equal to "1" absence.

Prep courses for all of the tests including EIKEN (STEP), TOEIC; Tourism English Proficiency English will be given to all students in this course. All of the students who have not taken/passed pre-2nd grade of EIKEN before should be required to pass it, and those who

have passed it before should be required to pass 2nd-grade or higher by the end of 2nd the semester.

Office hours will be announced in the first class.

1. Understand vocabulary associated with tourism
2. Understand tour brochures produced by tour operators
3. Understand tour itinerary and create own tour schedule while discussing with peers and the lecturer
4. Take care to possible trouble shoot during the travel
5. Develop skimming and scanning skills.
6. Deepen an understanding of different varieties of English, and communicate their opinions and ideas about them in English.
7. Submit a portfolio to the lecturer for assessment.
8. Pass / Get the following certificates: 2nd grade of EIKEN, or higher/600 points TOEIC, or higher/2nd or 3rd grade of TOURISM ENGLISH PROFICIENCY TEST.
