#### 授業目的

Students in Integrated English II will work to develop their reading, writing, speaking, and interpersonal skills. Students will expand their vocabulary, refine their reading ability, and engage in discussions as well as scholarly debates. Cooperative learning (group work) is an important part of this class and will help develop a student's leadership skills in addition to improving collaboration techniques.

A selection of topics linked to positive and negative peace will be used to develop their English language resources and interest in the values and actions that allow people to flourish in their globally interlinked societies. Students will practice good writing techniques by using a variety of skills. Through this combination of activities, members of this class will gain greater skills to draw upon when reading and writing.

##### EXPECTATIONS:

Attendance is very important. Students must attend 90% of all classes. Only personal or family emergencies and medical care are recognized as legitimate absences; otherwise, students are expected to attend classes. All the language courses at NUIS require students' participation in every class. Therefore, late arrivals are not tolerated. "2" late arrivals are equal to "1" absence. Prep courses for all of the tests including EIKEN (STEP), TOEIC: Tourism English Proficiency English will be given to all students in this course. All of the students who have not taken/ passed pre-2nd grade of EIKEN before should be required to pass it, and those who have passed it before should be required to pass 2nd-grade or higher by the end of 2nd the semester.
