| 授業の目的・テーマ | <p>Overseas Study B is offered to 4rh-year students who would like to participate in an overseas study or language seminar at higher institutions, internship or volunteer at government, NPG, NGO, etc. of their choice in a foreign country or Japan. This OPA can serve as an important stepping stone for students to build up their skills, resume, and cross-cultural understanding. They will apply their in-class knowledge to real-world meaningful work, gain hands-on experience, and expand their skill base.</p> <p>A variety of opportunities and tailored/non-tailored programs have been conducted before in USA, Cambodia, Canada, the Philippines, Russia, Taiwan, New Zealand since 2014.</p> <p>Upon completion of their study/work, students must produce a final video, presentation, or similar deliverable presenting the outcome/results of their experience in the 2nd semester.</p>   |     |   |    |    |
| 内容        | <p>Students are required to undertake a summer program/seminar or an internship for a minimum of 1 week or longer during summer break to receive a passing grade. They are expected to find study/internship opportunities themselves. Once found, students are required, before beginning the summer program/seminar or internship, to obtain permission from their seminar teacher after submitting their study/project plan, while attending "A Guide to Overseas Study". They need to submit (1) Weekly/Daily Reports, and (2) a Study/Internship Summary Report to their advisor in the seminar. The host organization will also be asked to submit an Evaluation Sheet, which must be sent directly to the Academic Office at NUIS. Lastly, students are required to make a presentation about their study/internship either in English or their chosen language in the 2nd semester. Upon satisfying these requirements, students will be awarded 1 credit. The length of the preparatory study &amp; work and follow-up report should amount to at least 15 hours.</p> |     |   |    |    |
