	BEGINNER (N5–N4)	Can understand basic Japanese to some extent. ▪ Can read and understand standard phrases and sentences written in Hiragana, Katakana, and basic Kanji used in daily life. ▪ Can understand the content of short, slowly-spoken conversations in everyday situations (ex. in a classroom or daily surroundings).
	INTERMEDIATE (N4–N3)	Can understand Japanese used in everyday situations to some extent. ▪ Can understand the main points and specific details of coherent conversations spoken at near-natural speed in everyday situations.
